NOTE: An ejection for fighting carries a **two** game suspension for the first offense and a **four** game suspension for subsequent fighting ejections.

DEFINITION OF FIGHTING - Fighting is any attempt by a player or nonplayer to strike or engage an opponent in a combative manner not related to that sport. Fighting may occur when the ball is dead or alive. Fighting includes, but is not limited to, combative acts such as: An attempt to strike an opponent with a fist, hands, arms, legs or feet, whether or not there is contact; an attempt to instigate a fight by committing an unsportsmanlike act toward an opponent that causes an opponent to retaliate by fighting.
